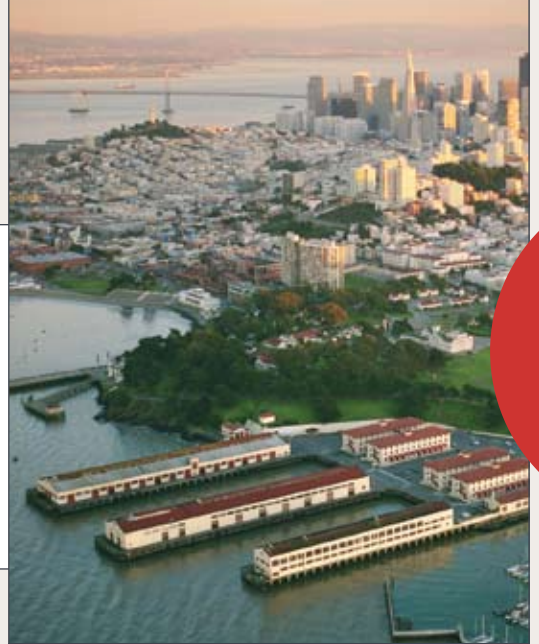

LOCATION

Located on San Francisco's northern waterfront, Fort Mason Center, a National Historic Landmark, offers spectacular views of the San Francisco Bay from the Golden Gate Bridge and Marin Headlands to Angel Island, Alcatraz and the East Bay hills.

SPECIAL EVENT FACILITIES

Two historic pavilions originally built as a military port of embarkation today provide versatile venues for tradeshow, festivals, product launches and special events, including music, film and video productions. Both pavilions offer column-free exhibit space, direct vehicular access, show offices or storage, robust power solutions, excellent catering facilities and exterior access for spectacular views.

Herbst Pavilion

30,000 sq. ft.; holds up to 3,000
 110 booths 10' x 10'

Festival Pavilion

50,000 sq. ft.; holds up to 5,000
 180 booths 10' x 10'

Conference Center: Consists of three venues with views of the marina and the Golden Gate Bridge. Rooms can be used separately or together for meetings, seminars, art exhibits, retreats, tradeshow, receptions or other events.

Firehouse: Perfect for receptions, meetings, retreats and classes, the Firehouse is a charming special event space. The building offers a large room that holds up to 100, a smaller adjoining room and semi-private outdoor space overlooking the bay with views of Angel Island and Alcatraz.

Meeting and Activity Rooms: Eleven individual rooms located in two historic buildings are ideal for breakout sessions and can accommodate from eight to 100 people with a variety of setup possibilities

Cowell Theatre: The 437-seat Cowell provides an ideal space for lectures and presentations as well as film, dance, music, theater. Superb sound and lighting systems.

San Francisco MOMA Artists Gallery: The clean, modern lines of the Artists Gallery are ideal for receptions, ceremonies, cocktail parties and other affairs for up to 150 people.

Southside Theater: The 160-seat theater with a proscenium stage provides a wonderful location for breakouts, seminars, presentations and intimate performances.
